Children, Divine Mother has not entered into Maha Samadhi. She is ever with you. Seated in Dharma Peetam, She is still the Living Force here. It is love for the children that keeps Her amongst Her children. In all incarnations, the annihilation of asuras was a part of the divine work. In this avatara, there is only the annihilation of the evil tendencies, the evil forces, lurking in the human bosoms, with the sword of Knowledge.

When Mother descended into this world as the Avatara, She brought with Her a principle, a moral ideal, upon which Her whole life was built. The Garhasthya life of Mother was not a mere family life. It was a life of dharmanishta and taponishta. Home was Her temple, the ashram of peace. Renouncing all divine splendor of Her abode, She became a wife, a Grahini, a Sahadharmini, and did intense tapas even forgoing sleep for six months.

Meticulously performing all household duties, She built the adhyatmic mansion and emerged from the privacy of home to the wide world as the Jagadguru, moved by compassion towards the suffering human race. Prem and vairagya together blazed forth in Her. The great forces of Hers, tapas, love, dharma and sacrifice, yielded fruit and it is that fruit that you are enjoying today. The same fruit the world will enjoy tomorrow.

Are you not the heroic children of such a Mother? Is not Her blood flowing through your veins? Follow Her Teaching. Let Her qualities be reflected in you. Face the problems of life with courage. Rise above pleasure and pain and be established in peace. If homes rise in spirituality, the whole world will be spiritually elevated. Bring up your children on the path of dharma and truth and then dedicate them to God.

The outstanding quality of a woman as eulogized in Hindu scriptures, is Tyaga, self-abnegation. So long as self persists, there is no dawn of illumination. Spirit of sacrifice pervades all activities of a housewife wedded to dharma. Her service of the husband, hospitality to guests and rearing up of the children, all become spiritual, through that great virtue, Tyaga. Tyaga is Her very nature. With Tyaga and dharma as her great attributes, she is the queen of the home, a servant of God and a minister to her husband. Dharma is her honour, her protective talisman.

Children, a great fire is burning and blazing in Mother's heart. How can Mother describe it to you! How can you understand it, so long as you remain tied to the ego? Let your ego dissolve in ecstatic devotion to Divine Mother. You cannot get the coolness or shade or breeze under it. Come and sit under the shade of God's grace. Love God with all your heart. Bhaktas are filled with love for God. Santa Tukaram's wealth was bhakti. Name of God was the sheet anchor of his life. God was his father, mother, friend, companion and salvation. Draw inspiration from the lives of such saints and aspire to lead a God-dedicated life.
