Vigraha Prathishta Celebrations of Devi Sree Ramambika – A Report.

The programme of Vigraha Prathishta Celebrations of Devi Sree Ramambika was well attended by devotees from almost all our centers, even though this happened to be just within a month from the Birthday celebration on the 4th of March.

The celebrations started with Udayasthamana Sree Lalitha Sahasranama yajna. It is the potent form of worship to invoke Sree Lalitha Parameswary, the Supreme Shakti of the universe.

Sree Maha Ganapathy Homa is performed at every auspicious undertaking to ward off any unforeseen impediments. Sree Maha Ganapathy is not only in-separable from Divine Mother but also an aspect of Divine Mother.

Sree Chandika Homa is performed to vanquish the evil forces and to confer success and fearlessness to the devotees. For the children of Divine Mother, Sree Tara Devi Herself is Sree Devi Chandika. Sree Chandika Devi is propitiated through Saptha-Shathi – 700 manthras.

Rathotsavam on the Prathishta night was a most beautiful part of the entire celebrations. The sacred Utsava Murty of Devi Sree Ramambika was brought in the newly made Pallakki, carried by the ceremoniously dressed devotees, with all temple decorations, from the shrine to the waiting Ratham in the front courtyard. That was a sight for the gods to see the smooth sailing Ratham through the newly made roads in the precincts.

All the participants experienced joy, happiness and peace due to subtle presence and special Grace of Divine Mother.

Two special programmes were held during the month of April, 2015:-

(1) Harikatha Saptaha organized in association with Harikatha Parishath, Mangalore, on Bhakthi Vijaya – 9th to 15th.

(2) Adhyatmic Shibir – Marathi and Hindi – 24th to 26th.

Harikirthan is one of the devotional approaches to the Supreme. This is one of the very effective medium of communication of glories of Divine, understandable to even an illiterate. In olden days, the great bhaktas like Purandaradas, Kanakadas, Tukaram, Ekanath, Tulsidas and the host of others used to do Harikeerthan and lift audience to a higher level of consciousness and make them feel the presence of God during their God-intoxicating rendering of glories of God.

They have all done yeomen services for spreading Sanathana Dharma. In Shaktinagar the Harikeerthan was very interesting and educative. Some of them were very absorbing.

Harikeerthan on Sant. Tukaram evoked great interest in the audience. The Keerthankar was a famous Haridas. Melodious songs and elevating talk attracted good response from the audience.

The Keerthanas on Bhaktha Purandaradasa, Koloora Kodagusu, Bhakta Gora Kumbara, and Swami Vivekananda in English were very absorbing.

In all, the Saptaha registered great success in communicating the glories of God.

(2) The Adhyatmic shibir in Marathi and Hindi was an achievement in itself, even though this was organized after a large gap of many years. The participants took keen interest in the programmes.

In the inaugural address, it was highlighted that sadhana is a continuous process. Whatever walk of life a sadhaka takes, it should be converted into sadhana, centered in one's atman. All duties should be offered to God. Then it becomes a sadhana.

Divine Mother always insists on silence, dhyana and continuous 'vichara' on Atman. This leads to transformation of Anthakarana leading to higher planes of spirituality.

Talk on importance of Divine Mother's teaching in practical life was very beneficial to the participants. The pravachana on five limbs of yoga – Shraddha, Veerya, Smrithi, Samadhi and Prajna, as enunciated by Mother was very important from the point of view of sadhana. The participants expressed keen interest in organizing Sadhana shibir every year henceforth.

Divine Mother Says, "God is the Supreme value (paramartha). To realize Him is not that easy. But it is indeed easy for the votaries of truth, who abide in Dharma, who have staunch faith, whose yearning for God is intense. When you adhere to Dharma at all costs, God comes to you and reveal Himself to you."
