I. 40th Anniversary celebrations of Vighraha Prathishta of Devi Sree Ramambika – A Report.

Highlights.

(1) Sree Maha Ganapathy Homa – performed to ward off any impediments to the progress of the Mission. He is first to be worshipped in all auspicious occasions. His Matrubbhakti is second to none. Devi Parvathy created Him out of Her own sankalpa and has been invested with infinite powers. Divine Mother Sree Tara Devi says that He is Parabrahman Himself. Divine Mother Sree Tara Devi assumed the bhava of Maha Ganapathy and Devi Gowri during Sree Ganesha Chaturthi day in the past.

(2) Sree Chandika Homa – This is specially performed to destroy the inimical forces obstructing the developmental activities of the Mission. This is an elaborate homa, reciting the 700 potent manthras (saptashati). Incidentally Sree Tara Devi is Devi Sree Chandika as declared by Divine Mother Sree Rama Devi. Sree Chandika Devi is one of the aspects of Supreme Shakthi. Sree Tara Devi achieved within Two and a half years of Her ministry what thousands of human beings cannot achieve in 100 years, which indicates Her Chandika aspect.

(3) Udayasthamana Sree Lalitha Sahasranama Yajna – It is a very powerful form of yajna to invoke Parashakthi. Sree Lalitha appears in “Sree Vidya”. Sree Vidya was imparted to Sree Agasthya Maharshi by Lord Hayagreeva, who popularized it in the world.

Ceremonial procession of “Utsava Murthy” is one of the important features of the celebration. Devi Sree Ramambika (Utsava Murthy) seated in Silver Ratham is taken in ceremonial procession throughout the Shaktinagar complex. This is the occasion the children of Mother talk to Mother and pray to Mother in close proximity. Sree Devi listens all our prayers and supplications. Here there is a close bond of Divine intimacy for the children of Mother which all enjoy.

The bhajans were heart-touching and elevating. Kolu Festival is celebrated to propitiate the Guardian Deities - Annappa Swamy and Sathyadevatha.

Thus the Vighraha Prathishta celebrations were a grand and glorious success.

II. Vighraha Prathishta Anniversary celebrations of Sree Maha Ganapathy

The Vighraha Prathishta Anniversary celebrations of Sree Maha Ganapathy recorded grand success by the Grace and blessings of Divine Mother, Devi Sree Ramambika. The salient features were Sree Maha Ganapathy Homa and Ranga Pooja to Sree Maha Ganapathy.

Sree Maha Ganapathy Homa along with Sannidhya Havana and dwadasha Kalashabhisheka were performed to ward off negative influences if any, coming in the way of communions between the devotees and the Divine and to maintain spiritually vibrant atmosphere in the Sanctum. The Ranga Pooja was performed to propitiate Sree Maha Ganapathy, along with all His Ganas, with prayers, supplications and worship to invoke His grace and blessings on all devotees.

The installation of beautiful Krishna Shila Vighraha of Sree Maha Ganapathy and consecration of Shrine dedicated to His worship took place on 12th June, 1981, in Shaktinagar. This event had been predicted by Divine Mother years ago. This is one of the significant events in the history of Rama Sakti Mission. A large number of devotees from all over India and abroad had then participated in the Prathishta Celebrations of the Sree Maha Ganapathy Vighraha.

III. Sree Rama Devi Adhyatma Sangha, Madikeri – 53rd Anniversary celebrations of Vighraha Prathishta and Sadhana Sibira – A Report.

The entire programme was well organized by a few devotees of the Sangha. The Co-operation and dedication of the devotees is worthy of adoration and worthy of emulation. The talk on 'what is spirituality and How?' By Sri. Anandaraya Kamath was well dealt with proper illustrations and the audience appreciated the way of presentation and the content and the matter was very useful. The Harikatha on Themes (1) 'Ya Devi Sarva Bootheshu Lakshmy roopena samsthitha' and (2) 'Ya Devi Sarva Bootheshu Matru roopena samsthitha' were very well explained by well known Haridas – Dr. Gurudas – with copious illustrations, parables and melodious music. Though the themes were very intricate, keerthankar with his vast knowledge in the field made them understandable to the audience and drew applause from them. The rendering of the themes were touching and educative.

The talk on Sree Devi Gaana Namana by Pandit K.V. Nandakumar was very fine. His father a famous carnatic musician composed nearly 100 songs in praise of Divine Mother Sree Rama Devi. Every song depicts the glory of Divine Mother. Sri. Nandakumar gave wonderful commentary on some songs and the audience was very much impressed. His father himself was wonderstruck to have composed a song in "Lalitha panchama raga" which he was not very much conversant. He humbly says that he was simply an instrument of Mother and Mother Herself inspired and made him to compose. All songs are very meaningful for Mother's children. Sri. Nandakumar's rendering was very insightful and educative.

The bhajans, were melodious, inspiring and elevating.

The celebration and sadhana sibiram ended with a golden note "grand success".

A few members who worked very hard – Sri. C.A. Muthanna, Smt. Kumari Harry, Dr. Gurudas and others, to make the function a grand success, deserve a special thanks and appreciation from all participants.

This programme has a great impact on the contemporary society and it is a message for the younger generation to involve themselves constructively in this regenerative work of Divine Mother, the Supreme Shakti.
