Divine Mother Sree Tara Devi, the sweet name brings before us the Radiant face, the enchanting smile, filling all who have seen Her with bliss. Her life was a song of love and dedication. Her every breath was a ceaseless worship at the Altar of Gurubhakthi. She emphatically said, "Blessed are those who become instruments in Mother's Cause, to throw ourselves into Her Cause, in obedience to Her behests, to enshrine Her in our hearts, this is the deliverance, Mokhsa.

Guru Poornima is the most sacred day for the disciples and for all those who seek spiritual knowledge. The Supreme is the first Guru of all Creation. He created forces functioning in the innumerable planes. He is present in all beings as Presiding Presence. He guides and controls the beings from within as an unmanifested power, as a formless Guru. When the Cosmic need arises, the same invisible Guru becomes a visible splendor in an embodiment to guide the souls directly and to maintain the universal balance. He becomes the Jagadguru.

The Vighraha Prathishta anniversary celebration of Sree Maha Ganapathy on 28-5-2015 was a grand success by the grace and blessings of Divine Mother, Devi Sree Ramambika. Sree Maha Ganapathy homa along with Sannidya Havana, Dwadasha Kalashaabhishekam etc. were performed to ward off the evil influences and to enhance the Divine Presence in the Sanctum. Finally Ranga Pooja was performed to propitiate Sree Maha Ganapathy with Heartfelt prayers to shower His grace and blessings on all, including those that could not be personally present on the occasion but offer their supplications from their far off places.

The installation of beautiful Krishna Shila Vighraha of Sree Maha Ganapathy and the consecration of the Shrine took place on 12th June, 1981, in Shaktinagar. This was one of the significant events in the history of Rama Sakti Mission. Years ago, this event had been predicted by Divine Mother Sree Rama Devi. The installation of the Vighraha took place at the sacred muhurtham at 6.45am in the immediate Presence of Divine Mother Sree Tara Devi. Sree



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Maha Ganapathy Vighraha shone radiant and vibrant. Everyone felt the Divine Presence. Divine Mother Sree Tara Devi was present throughout the ceremony and the devotees were happy in the company of Divine Mother. In addition to the vedic rites invoking Divine Presence in the Vighraha, Divine Mother Sree Tara Devi imparted Divine Power to the Vighraha.

In one of Her discourses, Sree Tara Devi expressed that Sree Ganapathy represents Brahman Himself and bestow viveka (discrimination). The dawning of viveka alone ensures success in spiritually dedicated life. It is the light of viveka that guides one unerringly on this path of truth; this truth is affirmed by the tradition that Sree Ganapathy is the first God invoked in all religious undertakings.

Sree Ganapathy is the Divine child created by Devi Parvathy out of Her own Sankalpa and Chaithanya. By His exemplary devotion to His mother Devi Sree Parvathy, He was raised to the position of worshipful Deity. This holds great lesson for spiritual aspirants. Steady devotion to Sree Devi raises the devotee to the highest state of oneness with the Supreme.

Sadhana Sibiram at Madikeri Mandir – A Report. (29-05-2015 to 31-05-2015)

This is the first time that the Madikeri Mandali conducted the Sibiram. It was a grand success beyond all expectations. The atmosphere is conducive for sadhana. The Mandir is surrounded by lush green trees with cluster of temples around and a rare peace pervading the atmosphere. The Sibiram was conducted along with the 52nd anniversary celebrations of Vighraha Prathishtha of Devi Sree Ramambika.

In the inaugural address, it was stressed that the programme was in accordance with the will of Divine Mother. The object of the Sibiram was to create inspiration and enthusiasm in the minds of the participants to take up the sadhana seriously and to raise themselves up in the spiritual field and become the participants in Divine Mother's work of regeneration of Bharath.

The talks on ego, Nama japa, sadhana and message of Divine Mother were uniformly good. The "Santa Darshan" was an interesting programme – singing of songs of different saints with commentary.

The history of Sree Rama Devi Adhyatma Sangha, Madikeri was awe inspiring to the devotees. How a few ardent disciples of Divine Mother sacrificed and developed the Mandali to the present state is a rare event in the ministry of Divine Mother. In one of the talks it was stressed how Divine Mother's will worked and in every event the working of Divine Mother's Hand. During the inaugural function of the Mandir in the year 1963 Divine Mother went into Samadhi for an hour. Mother did not talk inside the mandir. After coming out of the Mandir Mother said, "I could not talk inside because I see in each brick of the Mandir the tears and sacrifice of the devotees". The marble Vighraha of Devi Sree Ramambika was sanctified by both the Divine Mothers.



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Divine Mother Sree Rama Devi imparted Divine Power to the Vighraha at the Wagh's studio (sculpter) in Mumbai. Sree Tara Devi did the consecration of the Vighraha. When Divine Mother Sree Tara Devi touched the Vighraha (1971, 31st July) it started glowing with additional radiance. Again on 31st May 1979, Sree Tara Devi adorned the Vighraha with the crown. In the words of Sree Tara Devi, "the moment I touched the vighraha of my Deva, the Vighraha became chaithanya Swaroopam and I experienced that She and Myself are one. Later Sree Tara Devi assumed the Bhava of Sree Devi Lalithambika – thus the Madikeri Mandir is exceptional in getting the Divine Power from both the Mothers.

The Harikatha on 'Abhaya Daayini Jaganmathe' was very good and educative also. The keertankar explained at length the Abhaya (bestower of fearlessness) quality of Sree Devi. Divine Mother, the Supreme Shakti being the creator of universe has no ill will towards any creature. Her hands are raised in Abhaya to all. Whosoever takes refuge in Her, will be protected by Her. Even when fighting against Rakshas, She was playfully fighting to make the Rakshas understand Her Abhaya nature.

The Keerthankar with melodious songs and parables, made the audience happy and joyous. Thus the Sibiram ended with a golden note "grand success".

We sincerely wish all other Mandalis too emulate this example of well organized Sadhana Sibiram in respective Mandalis. Participation is important not formality. Obviously earlier devotees may now have gone to faraway places because of their occupation, marriage etc. In the name of Sadhana Sibiram all could be brought together to share their views, experiences and ideas to enhance the strength of the Mandali.

Divine Mother Says, "Ego is the greatest impurity. Jnana destroys the ego. Jnana is considered to be the greatest purifier. In the state of Bhakti, the individuality is lost and the devotee is filled with God. The devotees imbibe the quality of God. Hence, Bhakti is purity itself.



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Be it our spiritual privilege to participate in the most auspicious celebrations – 85th year of Advent of Divine Mother Sree Tara Devi and the Sacred Guru Poornima - in the bond of Divine friendship to imbibe the special vibrations emanating from the sacred Shrines of Devi Sree Ramambika and Divine Mother Sree Tara Devi.
