Celebrations of Advent Day of Divine Mother Sree Tara Devi on the 20th July and Sacred Guru Pournima on 27th July recorded a grand success by the Grace and blessings of Divine Mother, Devi Sree Ramambika. Shaktinagar was vibrant with Divine Mother's Presence during the celebrations.

"Thara and I, we are one; you should not have any doubt at any time." Said Divine Mother Sree Rama Devi. Divine Mother Sree Tara Devi is the Avatar of Supreme Shakti. Elevation to Guru's real nature in the case of Sree Tara Devi is the unfolding of Her Godhood Consciousness as Devi Sree Lalithambika extolled in the "Durga Saptashathi".
