“Tara and I, We are one and you should not have any doubt at any time.” Said Divine Mother Sree Rama Devi. Divine Mother Sree Tara Devi is not merely a knower of Brahman but is the Avatar of the Supreme, the Parashakti. Elevation to Guru’s real nature in the case of Sree Tara Devi is the unfolding of Her God-hood consciousness as Devi Sree Lalithambika extolled in the “Durga Sapta Shathi.” Only the incarnations of Divinity, the Avatars, possess the Iswara Bhava, the God-hood consciousness. Divine Mother Sree Rama Devi made it very clear that one who possess the Iswara Bhava, alone becomes Jagadguru. Iswara Bhava is the overlordship of whole creation.
