When Avatars of the Supreme appear on earth, it is very difficult to recognize them. Only a few are blessed to know them. Sree Tara Devi, though a Supreme Being born in humble circumstances, had to struggle very hard in life because of the unfavourable conditions. She maintained Her serenity all through Her life. At the age of 4, She caressed a big cobra when she was taken to the nearby temple. People nearby were astounded to see a child playing with the cobra. Cobra must have understood Her Divine nature. When She saw Divine Mother Sree Rama Devi at the age of six, She lost Her body consciousness. She recognized Her Paramaguru and God. From that day onwards, She never wavered in Her devotion to Mother.

At the age of 13, by the mere touch of Divine Mother, She lost body consciousness for four days, saw all the lokas and saw Divine Mother Sree Rama Devi alone in all the Lokas and entered into Nirvikalpa Samadhi. She manifested Godhood consciousness on 16th June, 1979. Divine Mother Sree Rama Devi manifesting in Sree Tara Devi declared that 'She and I', we are one. You should not forget this at any time. After the Maha Samadhi of Divine Mother Sree Rama Devi, She carried forward the eternal message of Divine Mother, roused thousands, soothed hundreds and guided many. As the greatest Gurubhaktha, She achieved in Two and a half years of Her divinie Ministry what millions could not do in 100 years. She sacrificed everything at the altar of Guru Bhakthi. Duty towards Parama Guru was Her highest priority.

A REPORT: GOLDEN JUBILEE CELEBRATIONS OF FOUNDATION DAY OF RAMA SAKTI MISSION.

The celebrations were grand and glorious success by the grace of Divine Mother though we were in two minds in the beginning. Divine Mother's will only prevail. According to Her Para Sankalpa alone everything happens. It was five days' programme (31st October to 4th November, 2014). With invocatory prayer in Matrulinayam the programme commenced.

November 1st was very auspicious – Maha Samadhi Day of Divine Mother. The day was observed as silence day without much worldly talk. During the day of Her conscious exit from Her Divya upadhi She gave very valuable instruction to GB Members to abide by the Mother's eternal tenets and to carry forward the torch of Mother so that the world can be benefitted much. Besides, She gave the most glorious and the greatest Taraka Manthra "Charanam Sharanam Ramambike, Charanam Sharanam Trayambake"; so that the future generations can be saved from world of trials and travails. Mother blessed the whole world. Specially blessed are the children of Mother that She will be eternally present in Shaktinagar. Every year on that day we perform, Sree Durga Namsakara pooja, an elaborate worship to invoke the grace of Sree Durga Devi who is none other than our beloved Mother Devi Sree Ramambika Herself. After the worship during the silent prayer we actually felt the presence of Divine Mother, Her silent vibrations soothing our hearts.

The Golden Jubilee was commenced on Sunday, the 2nd November, 2014. In the inaugural address, a glimpse of Divine Mother's life and teachings were highlighted. Mother's life and teachings are unique in every respect. No human being can exhaust the glory of Divine Mother. When we look into ocean, we never find where it begins and where it ends. An audio visual on Blossoming of Rama Sakti Mission was well presented. New comers could get an idea of Rama Sakti Mission and how it is functioning and what are its impacts to the contemporary society. Sangeetha Seva by Gosreepuram sisters, Kochi was very good. Youngsters with melodious voice could lift the audience to a higher level of musical world giving joy and happiness to all.

On November 3rd was Karthika Ekadshi. Many devotees observe Ekadashi Vrata. By observing this vratha many attained salvation. Bhakta Ambarisha in ancient times attained salvation by meticulously observing this vratha. By the power of the vratha, he was unaffected by the curse of Durvasa Maharshi. On the contrary Durvasa was punished by the "Sudarshan Chakra" of Lord Maha Vishnu and finally he had to surrender to Ambarisha. Such is the greatness of "Shruddha" in sadhana. The day is dedicated to Lord Vitala (Panduranga). Ekadashi Bhajans on this day were very good, uplifting the audience and soothing to the listeners. Songs were mostly in praise of Lord Vittala.

Presentations by the Mandalis were very encouraging, interesting and educative too. Mandalis' formation, growth and developments, Mother's visit to Mandalis, messages of Mother are lessons for the children of Divine Mother. Talks on various subjects relating to Mother's life and teachings and propagation of Mother's principles are praise worthy. Each talk was very significant and there was much to learn especially for new comers. Those who could not personally come and participate sent their recordings, which were displayed on a big screen with a projector. The presentations were well organized, and the response was very encouraging. These programmes are opening new horizons in the eternal teachings of Divine Mother.

On November, 4th Uthana Dwadashi, the interactive session was evoking good response from the audience. Some of the topics were searching interest and innovative. On that day the topical programme was musical discourse on Para Sankalpa of Divine Mother by Dr. S.P. Gurudas. The renowned Katha Keerthankar, expounded the topic very lucidly combined with melodious music and copious parables. The subject is very profound and very vast, requires much contemplation and deep probe into the matter and the Grace of the Mother is very essential.

Divine Mother very often quoted about Para Sankalpa. It is the Divine law operating in the whole cosmos. According to great ones there are two laws operating in the universe – 1) Divine law (2) Natural law pertaining the creation. Natural law can be manipulated. When Avatars come down to earth, some laws will be formulated by the supreme consciousness that is known as para sankalpa according to Divine Mother. The avatars act in tune with the para sankalpa. Lord Krishna referred this para sankalpa in His last days. He says according to para sankalpa, I have done everything. Being the Supreme, I could have changed the course of action, but I did not want to do it."

An important aspect of today's programme was offering of "Pallakki", made in Shaktinagar, donated by devotees to Devi Sree Ramambika. At the time of sacred Tulasi pooja, the holy utsava Murthy was placed in the Pallakki and was ceremoniously taken to the Tulasi Mound. Pooja was offered both to Devi Sree Ramambika and Tulasi Devi. As per tradition, the ceremony is wedding of Tulasi Devi with Lord Maha Vishnu. Here, Lord Vishnu is Devi Sree Ramambika. The pooja is actually the wedding ceremony. Tulasi Devi is so important that no
