Divine Mother Sree Tara Devi is a Spiritual Phenomenon. To talk about Sree Tara Devi means to talk about whole spirituality itself. She is born great. With Her Bala Leelas She did endear Herself to one and all in the family, spreading unearthly joy and bliss, all around.

Experiences, stories and history fail to enable man to comprehend the glories of God, much less His incarnations. In spite of having elaborate details of manifestations of God on earth in yesteryugas it is indeed very very difficult to recognize the divine in human form. Consequently Sree Tara Devi had to undergo a lot of hardships during Her childhood and girlhood days.

From the beginning itself, She maintained Her equanimity. People around Her did not understand Her Perfection. Divine Mother's Protecting Hand was always with Her. She used to lose Her body consciousness even at Her young age.

Once when She was around four, went to a sacred theertha kshetra with other members of family. She saw a very big cobra in the vicinity. Girl ran to there and started caressing it with Her tiny hand to the utter horror of the onlookers. Cobra remained cool and docile. Even the crawling creature seems to have recognized Her divinity!!

At the age of six, there was a programme of bhajans and satsangh arranged for Divine Mother. Sree Tara Devi was not allowed to go to the venue at a distance, as She was running high temperature. But the urge to see the Divine Mother and the opportunity to be in Her sannidhya, was irresistible. Propelled by this intense longing She came out of the house and stood there wondering which way to go!! There was suddenly seen a big and broad beam of light. Sree Tara Devi followed the light and reached the programme site giving absolute surprise to everyone in the assembly!!

At the age of 13, by the mere touch of Divine Mother Sree Rama Devi, She was in Samadhi for 4 days, had the darshan of 14 lokas and entered into Nirvikalpa Samadhi. Divine Mother Sree Rama Devi was with Her and guiding Her. By this experience, Her connection with the world of matters snapped once for all and She realized Her true nature. She says by this experience, She was stationed in Her true centre always whatever be the external experiences. Her Guru bhakti is peerless. She proved in Her life that by Gruru bhakti nothing is impossible.

Her Godhood Consciousness was revealed in the year 1979, June, 16. She assumed the Bhavas and Bhava Aveshas of many Gods and Goddesses. The most eloquent was the Bhava of Divine Mother Sree Rama Devi, The Parama Guru. In that Bhava Divine Mother Sree Rama Devi declares "She and I, we are one and you should not have any doubt at any time. She is Devi Chandika. She will do the work hereafter."

Divine Mother Sree Tara Devi visited many Mandalies, gave solace to many and imparted spiritual awakening to hundreds. She used to be always in Divine Bhava.

It is very appropriate that we are celebrating Her Vighraha Prathishta on 21st December every year. The Vighraha Prathishta took place on 21st December, 1991 with Agamic rites. The Mandir dedicated to Sree Tara Devi is named as 'Dhyana Mandir', used only for meditation.

But none satisfied his longing to see God. Finally he was initiated by a Devi bhakta. All privations, hardships he bore keeping his goal alive. With many years of struggle and tapas, he got the darshan of Divine Mother Maha Kali. He held on to Maha Kali. Frequently he used to be in ecstasy of Maha Kali. After many years of hard tapas, he became very intimate bhakta of Devi Kali. He has composed many songs in praise of Devi mostly in ecstasy. His songs are popular in North India. Even Sree Ramakrishna Paramahams used to sing his songs.

The children's programme was grand and glorious. Compared to past many years this year's programme was very wonderful. It was a great feast to the ears and eyes. The standard was very high. Elders have great lessons from this programme. Singing, dancing, mono-acting, group songs and speaking about Mother, Her great teachings, all are exemplary. Divine Mother had very great love for young children. If they are trained well in accordance with Mother's teachings they will become torch bearers of future generations. Thus ended the Navarathri Mahotsava with a grand note.
